During **two four-hour sessions** we want to exchange experiences and ideas on how we actively address environmental racism and racist environmentalism in our community gardens. Through creative techniques including exercises, games, theatre, readings, film clips and discussion we will focus on the power structures we encounter and work towards imagining strategies to intervene in those.

The facilitators Mojisola Adebayo and Nicole Wolf will draw from their experimental workshop series Agri/cultural practices for climate justice. **A workshop on anti-racism, arts and ecology.** Their workshops are based on the acknowledgement of Agroecology (also referred to as permaculture) and Theatre of the Oppressed being informed by Indigenous and Black knowledge and experiences and focus on anti-racism, climate justice, decolonizing practices, addressing power structures, understanding the link between colonialism, plantation agriculture and environmental chaos.

The workshops will be most useful for those already committed to developing and applying tactics for anti-racist work in urban community gardens. **The workshop will be in English with German translation where possible.**
